

LEAFY SPURGE

Can be eaten by sheep and goats but considered toxic to cattle. With leaves 1-3 cm long, the plants are typically shorter than the spurge itself. This reproduces quickly from seeds and roots spreading underground coming up, and can reach the depth of 15 feet and spread laterally 30 feet

Visual of how much it can spread!

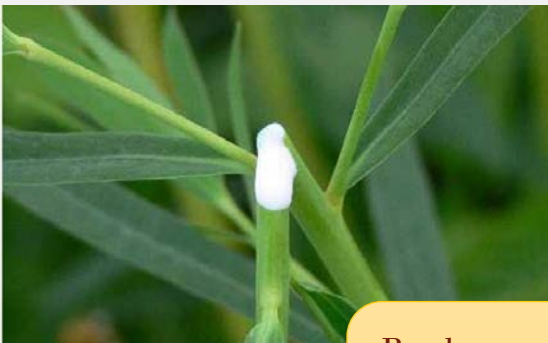


Life Span: Perennial
