Saltcedar



Growing in salt marshes, flood plains, and along rivers and streams, saltcedar can cause water to dry up in its presence. Ione plant can absorb 200 gallons of water and the seeds look like and are about the size of pepper, spreading by wind and water. A mature plant can produce 500,000 seeds per year and when left in a warm moist area will regrow



Management: Garlon - Late summer or early fall, <u>DO NOT</u> apply near irrigation ditches

Arsenal - Late summer or early fall, **DO NOT** apply near irrigation ditches

Life Span: Perennial
