INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

The following are instructions on how to vote your ballot. Please follow these instructions precisely, otherwise, your ballot may not be counted

1. Verify that there are initials of an election official at the bottom of the ballot.
2. Verify that there are no voting marks on the ballot.
3. Use a black ink pen to mark the ballot.
4. TO VOTE, you must darken the oval (●) completely.
5. Do NOT cross out or erase. If you make a mistake, contact the Saline County Clerk's Office for instructions at (402)-821-2374.
6. Place voted ballot into the brown return envelope. Write your NE driver's license or state ID in the space provided on the envelope, or enclose a photocopy of an acceptable photo ID or Reasonable Impediment Certification (if applicable). Complete, SIGN and seal the envelope. Remember to moisten both seals to cover the voter ID and signature boxes.
7. Any person physically unable to sign the envelope must make his/her "mark" and must have an individual witness. Failure to complete and sign the Return Identification Envelope will cause the ballot to be rejected.
8. Do NOT place more than ONE (1) voted ballot into the return identification envelope.
9. Return Ballot by:
 - a. Hand Delivery - deliver the ballot to the office of the County Clerk.
 - b. Mail - return ballot by mail by placing proper return postage on the envelope provided.
 - c. Drop Box Location - 204 South High Street, Wilber, NE 68465.
10. Ballot MUST be in the possession of the Saline County Clerk's Office by 5:00 p.m. Central Time on September 09, 2025.

Wilber Sales Tax 2025

"Shall the Mayor and City Council of Wilber, Nebraska increase the local sales and use tax by an additional one-half (1/2) of one percent (1%) from the current rate of one percent (1%) to a rate of one and one-half percent (1.5%) and impose a sales and use tax at the increased rate upon the same transactions within the municipality upon which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, with all revenues generated by the additional one-half (1/2) of one percent (1%) to be used for the specific purpose of funding improvements, repairs, replacements, extensions, and equipment purchases for said projects for streets, and the electrical, water and sewer systems of the City of Wilber, Nebraska?"

- ☐ Yes, for the additional one-half (1/2) of one percent (1%) sales and use tax for the specific purpose of funding improvements, repairs, replacements, extensions, and equipment purchases for said projects of the City of Wilber.
- ☐ No, Against the additional tax.

A "YES" VOTE: If a majority of the votes cast upon such question shall be in favor of increasing the local sales and use tax by an additional one-half (1/2) of one percent (1%), all the revenues generated by the additional one-half (1/2) of one percent (1%) shall be used for the specific purpose of funding improvements, repairs, replacements, extensions, and equipment purchases for said projects, for streets, and the electrical, water and sewer systems of the City of Wilber.

A "NO" VOTE: If a majority of those voting on the question shall be opposed to such increase of the local sales and use tax by an additional one-half (1/2) of one percent (1%), for the specific purpose of funding improvements, repairs, replacements, extensions, and equipment purchases for said projects, for the City of Wilber, then the governing body shall not impose such a tax increase, and the local sales and use tax rate will remain unchanged at one percent (1%).
